Paper title: The title must appear on your abstract and not exceed the **maximum of 60 characters**, including word spacing.

Coauthors: Include complete names, affiliations, mailing addresses, phone and fax numbers, and e-mail addresses for all authors on your abstract, and indicate who will serve as paper presenter. The paper presenter will be listed first in the program and will be the only author who will receive session information.

Topic area codes: Please include at least three of the three-character *JEL* codes that best fit your paper (visit our www.econlit.org/elclasbk.htm for a complete list). Print these codes in your preference order at the top right corner of your abstract.

Paper submission fee: \$65 per paper payable at the time of submission; waived for papers in organized sessions. See "Organize a Session" below.

Organize a Session

*Choose your own topic.
Get a colleague to help.*

As a current or newly joining member of a participating organization, you can organize your own session. Sessions normally include three or four paper presenters, three or four discussants, and a session chair. Time allocated for each session is one hour and 45 minutes. You might ask a colleague to share organizing responsibilities. Sessions are subject to approval by the Session Screening Committee. If you have any questions, contact the WEAI Executive Office. Please notify WEAI of your intent to organize a session by August 15; complete session information is due to WEAI by September 15.

Be a member of the WEAI 2005 Pacific Rim Conference Program Committee. All session organizers are recognized for their contribution to the conference program by being listed as a member of the Program Committee in the conference program.

Current members who are Institutional Member affiliates receive a complimentary conference registration if they organize a session in which at least four participants pay the usual registration fee. Two affiliates can share the organizing responsibilities and thus share the complimentary registration.
